The result of five years of war:

- Over half a million Iraqis have been killed, countless more have been injured for life.

- Illegal weapons are being used:cluster bombs, white phosphorous, depleted uranium

Schools, hospitals, entire cities, like Falluja, have been destroyed.

Women’s position is worse than before the war.

Violence against minorities has increased

Abu Ghraib has become a centre for torture. 70 000 people, including children are in jail today.

Between 4 and 5 million Iraqis (1/5 of the population) have been forced into exile or become refugees within their own country

Private security companies with 180 000 employed are terrorising and killing Iraqi civilians

4000 US soldiers have been killed and 10 000 have been injured.
